Working in collage,
Anton-David Ador gives life to a
colorful, hedonistic and offbeat
universe, by drawing his inspiration from
pinup boys, lifestyle, and surf culture. His
imagination gives rise to an abundance of "ideal"
cities and surreal stage sets; characters and fragments
of architecture and pop cultures sporadically picked from
different times and places. The viewer's gaze is pinged
around each composition like a pinball, picking up bits of
referred data at each new image, stimulating the spectrum of
our feelings and perceptions.



Each work is a small world in itself which emanates a joy of life
that this lover of the South-West coast of France cultivates with
insolence, brushing our dreams before approaching our
surreptitious fears. Because beyond the lightness and
carelessness that emerge from these visual shambles, we see
appearing a magnificent disappointment, staged often with
humor. The artist likes to confuse the issue, cultivating the
absurdity and extravagance with more or less esoteric details
and pretense. Anton-David Ador has exhibited globally, most
notably in London, Paris and other French cities.



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






I am a photographer and printmaker from south Florida with my partner of 5 years. My first art book, *EVINCIENT*, features often-nude male subjects, most of whom have never have been nude in front of a camera before.

I prefer to work with subjects who are not professional models, but merely people who want to explore themselves and their lives through a different lens. In that way, my work tries to be raw and honest. The subject lets the viewer into their world without filters or pretension, but also with the uneasiness, fear, and excitement that opening oneself can bring. It's that juxtaposition that drives my work: anxiety and trepidation of the unknown and untraveled mixed with the fearlessness of exposure. By exploring the everyday lives and bodies of other men who may share our own insecurities, fears, and hopes, it allows us to explore our individuality and appreciate our own unique beauty.
